Reading Plan for 1 Peter

It's one thing to simply read the Bible, but when you interact with it, when you learn to slow down and really read it, suddenly words start popping off the page! SOAPing your daily reading allows you to dig deeper and "see" more than if you simply read the verses and moved on. Join us as we dig in to 1 Peter these next five weeks. Our hope is to be taught by the Holy Spirit and to live out these truths alongside one another!

What is SOAP?

S – stands for Scripture. Read the passage. Read it a few times, silently and out loud, with a pen in hand. You may even want to choose one key verse and write it out. Then answer the question: "What do I see?"

O – stands for Observation. Who is the audience? Do you see any repetition of words? What words stand out to you? Is there anything I don't understand? What does this teach me about God? What does this teach me about man? What does this teach me about the Gospel?

A – stands for Application. This is when God's Word becomes personal. What is God saying to me today? How can I apply what I just read? Is there an action I need to take?

P – stands for Prayer. Ask God to help you understand and apply what you read today. Take time to thank him for working in your life. If he has revealed something to you during this time, pray about it. Ask him for opportunities to share what you are learning. Ask for strength and power to apply his word during your day.
